Sunday February 27 This day began with light wind from the SW and clear weather. Coal under all sails set on Port tack heading N W. "Grayhound" in sight at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Monday February 28 This day began with light wind with calm. Coal under all sails set on Port tack, store off NW. Saw hump back crew scup the mast fore and main pump attended to.

Tuesday February March 1 This day light breezes from SW with clear weather in morning we raised a school of small whales going quick to the windward we lower three Boats could not head them the Boats returned on board, pump attended to.

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Wednesday March 2 This day light breezes from SW with clear weather. Coal under all sails set on Port tack store off NW. Saw a Finback crew clean the iron works pump attended to.
Lat 12° 09' S Long 8° 20' E

Thursday March 3 This day light breezes from SW with clear atmosphere. Coal under all sails set on Port tack, store NW. Saw lots of Finbacks pump attended to.
Lat 11° 19' S Long 6° 30' E

Friday March 4 This day began with moderate breezes from SE and clear atmosphere. Coal under all sails set on Port tack store off NW by W. Saw a Finback crew employed scup the iron works pump attended to.
Lat 10° 26' S Long 5° 02' E

Saturday March 5 This day began with moderate wind from SW with clear weather. Coal under all sails set on Port tack running off store NW by W. crew making senete pump attended to.
Lat 9° 48' S Long 3° 11' E

Sunday March 6 This day began with light breezes from SW with clear weather. Coal under all sails set on Port tack running off store NW by W. Saw Porpoises pump attended to.
