Friday April 15 this day fresh breezes from S.E. with rain and squally vessel under low sails on Starboard tack running off Stere. W.W. pump attended to.

Saturday April 16 this day fresh breezes from S.E. with clear weather. Latter part dead calm. Vessel head N.W. by W. pump attended to.
Lat 13° 53' N Long 57° 54' W
Lat 14° 33' N Long 58° 48' W

Sunday April 17 this day moderate wind with clear weather. Vessel under all sails, set on Starboard tack Stere off N.W. by W. pump attended to at 1 P.M. we sighted the Martinique.
Lat 14° 55' N Long 59° 41' West

Monday April 18 at 7:30 A.M. we came to anchor at Dominica with very light wind from N.E. and rain, we anchor on 17 fathoms. Water. Near the vessel here "Richard W. Clark" "Towner" "Cameo" "John Manta" "Platina" "Grayhound" our watch went shore on night and returned on board next morning.

Tuesday April 19 at Dominica with rain all day. We watch the vessel out side.

Wednesday April 20 at Dominica with rain and squally all day.

Thursday April 21 at Dominica with fine weather. We commence to crocking out oil to put on deck and refilled.

Friday April 22 at Dominica with clear weather and calm we haul the vessel along side of the Clark to discharge the oils.

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Saturday April 23 this day at Dominica with fine weather we finished discharge the oils and took provision on board.

Sunday April 24 at Dominica with fine weather the crew went on shore and returned on board the next day we got out from Schooner.

Monday April 25 at Dominica with fine weather. We stow the vessel and setting up the coals. We discharge two men John Alves to mate and John Boesfeld Steward.

Tuesday April 26 at Dominica with fresh breezes. We take water on board and setting up the cask, and we take 4 bags Sugar from shore 880 lbs. (T. Towner and John Manta) sails in morning.

Wednesday April 27 at Dominica with fine weather. We take some water on board.

Thursday April 28 at Dominica with heavy rain all day.

Friday April 29 at Dominica with fine weather we take some water on board and 6 Cord of Wood.

Saturday April 30 at Dominica with fresh breezes. We finish taken water on board and we paint the vessel outside.

Sunday May 1 at Dominica with fine weather. One watch went on shore and returned on board at noon and the other went.

Monday May 2 at Dominica with squally and rain all day we took some two pumps on board. Send from New York.
