Saturday June 11 This day very light wind from SE with clear weather, vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading SE. Saw a black fish - at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to. Saw a merchant bound to NE

Sunday June 12 This day fresh breeze from SE with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading East. Saw a lot of porpoises at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday June 13 This day strong breeze from NW with rain and rough sea on vessel under shorting sails standing on Windward on Port tack. Saw a porpoise pump attended to
Lat 32:30 Long 48:15 W.

Tuesday June 14 This day light wind from SW with clear weather vessel under all sails on Starboard tack heading South. Crew making sunnits at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 32:19 Long 47:56 W.
