Saturday June 25 This day light breeze from SW with clear weather vessel under shorting sails on starboard tack boiling we put some oil down pump attended to.

Sunday June 26 This day strong breeze from SW with clear weather vessel under shorting sails on starboard tack at 1 o'clock A.M. we finished boiling and we stow down oils. Baromet Red start new cask, the cask was mark, 5 3/4 barrels, but only 3 3/4 we find on the cask pump attended to.

Monday June 27 This day strong breeze with rough sea on vessel under two try sails and full standing on windward on starboard tack later part heavy rain squall with cloudy weather pump attended to.

Tuesday June 28 This day strong wind from SW with squall and rain vessel under shorting sails on port tack heading West pump attended to Andre Magides, throw a piece of bread over board No observation Sun Regure

Nickerson" at 6: P.M. the Capt returned on board we shorting sails heave to for the night pump attended to.

Thursday June 30 This day fresh breeze from SW and smoky at daylight we made all sails on starboard tack heading South "Bertha Nickerson" and "Pedro Varela" in sight in morning an other schooner to the windward, at 3:30 P.M. "Nickerson" and Pedro went out sight at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 34:02 N Long 47:29 West

Friday July 1 This day strong breeze from SW and smoky at daylight we made low sails on starboard tack heading S.E. at 8: A.M. we raised a large whale going quick to the windward we could not head them "Bertha Nickerson" and "Comes" in sight at 2: P.M. at sun set we shorting sails heave to for the night pump attended to.

Lat 33:59 N Long 47:37 West

Saturday July 2 This day strong breeze from SW with rough sea on vessel under shorting sails, standing on windward on port tack at noon wore ship on starboard tack. Saw a whaling schooner, to the windward of us, one of the shawl plate got out we put new bolts and set up the regure pump attended to.
