Tuesday July 19 This day light wind from SE and clear weather in morning we made sails on Port tack heading NE at 7:30 P.M. we raised a school of ~~Small~~ ^{Large} whales we lower two boats we caught him L.B. at noon we take this whale along side and put gear up commence to cutting and we separate the head left some to be finished the next day we start fire pump attended to
