Friday July 29 - This day light wind from SE and clear atmosphere at 6: A.M. we raised a school of bulls whale we lower two boats caught 2 - L.B. - 1 - S.B. - 1 - take these whales along side at noon and we were to cutting the next day we was full deck we put some oil down pump attended to
No observation this day

Saturday July 30 This day light breeze from SE and cloudy in morning we set main sails and start to cutting whale at 7: A.M. we finished and shorting sails saw a merchant ship bound to North pump attended to

Sunday July 31 This day light breeze from SE and clear weather. Vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack, boiling saw a merchant vessel bound to SE we stow down some oil pump attended to

Monday August 1 This day light breezes from SE and clear weather, in morning we made all sails on Port tack heading SEW - boiling at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 34:30 N Long 45:48 W

Tuesday August 2 This day fresh breezes from SE and clear atmosphere Vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack head ENE we finished boiling and stow down some oil and we set up some casks pump attended to

Lat 34:27 N Long 45:47 W

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Wednesday August 3 This day light wind from SW and clear at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack heading SSE "Comes" and merchant man in sight to the windward, we finished stow down at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 34:39 N Long 45:53 W

Thursday August 4 This day very light wind from SW and clear weather, in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack heading SSE at 7: A.M. we raised a lone whale L.B. struck him and lizing line burst and boat returned on board at 5: P.M. we spoke to "Comes" with 300 barrels, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 34:31 N Long 45:38 W

Friday August 5 This day dead calm all day vessel under no sails set Capt went on board of "Comes" and returned at 6: P.M. no observation this day

Saturday August 6 This day dead calm all day vessel under no sails set we set up the fore and main - regus pump attended to "Comes" in sight

Lat 34:36 N Long 45:24 W

Sunday August 7 This day light breeze from SW and clear weather at day light we made all sails on Port tack head West "Comes" in sight in morning at noon we raised a large whale we lower two boats L.B. struck a bull whale we take the whale along side at 4:30 P.M. and we put gear up and shorting sails pump attended to
