Tuesday August 9 This day fresh breeze from SW and clear weather vessel under shorting sails boiling at noon we spoke to "J. Sawyer" - we set up some casks pump attended to

Wednesday August 10 This day fresh breeze from SW and rough sea on vessel under shorting sails on Port tack at 9: AM we finished boiling and we set up some casks and stowed down some casks "J. Sawyer" in sight to the windward, saw school of killer pump attended to

Lat 34:30 N Long 44:10 W

Thursday August 11 This day very strong wind from SW and squally vessel under two topsails and fore stay sails on Starboard tack heading S E "J. Sawyer" in sight vessel shipped much water on deck pump attended to

Friday August 12 This day strong breeze with rough sea on vessel under two topsails and fore stay sails on Port tack heading West by N "J. Sawyer" in sight at 6: PM the wind shifted to the Eastward with rain and cloudy - pump attended to

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Saturday August 13 This day moderate wind from East and cloudy with rain vessel under main topsails fore sails and fit on Port tack heading South "J. Sawyer" went out right at noon, at 6: PM we wore ship on Starboard tack pump attended to

Sunday August 14 This day fresh breeze from S E - and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading South at 4: PM we wore ship on Starboard tack at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to

Monday August 15 This day light NW wind and very clear weather in morning we made all sails on Port tack steering East - crew making dinner at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 34:31 N Long 42:49 W

Tuesday August 16 This day very light wind with calm vessel under shorting sails laying round crew scrub the iron works pump attended to

Lat 34:28 N Long 42:14 W

Wednesday August 17 This day fresh breeze from SW - and clear weather vessel under fore sails main topsail and head sails on Starboard tack steering off S E - saw a Grampus at sun set we took in fore sail set fore try sails pump attended to
