Thursday September 8 This day very light wind from East and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading S by E - for Fayal, pump attended to. No observation.

Friday September 9 This day light wind with calm vessel under all sails set - steve S by E. to Fayal land in sight crew wash the vessel in side pump attended to. No observation.

Saturday September 10 This day fresh breeze from SW - and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard running off to Fayal at 9: A.M. we anchor at Fayal and morning the vessel found more the Whales in one watch went shore on night.

Sunday September 11 This day light wind from SW - and clear. we watch the vessel in sight and start to paint.

Monday September 12 at St. Michael's with fine weather we paint the vessel outside and set up some casks we take a cooper from shore.

Tuesday September 13 at St. Michael's with fine weather crew working on setting up the casks.

Wednesday Sept 14 at Fayal with fresh breeze and clear weather crew employed on setting up the casks.

Thursday Sept 15 at Fayal with fine weather crew employed on discharge the oils.

Friday Sept 16 at Fayal with fine weather crew employed on discharge the oils.

Saturday Sept 17 at Fayal with fresh breeze and showery weather crew employed on discharge the oils.

Sunday Sept 18 at Fayal with fresh breeze and clear weather crew employed on discharge the oils.

Tuesday Sept 20 At Fayal with calm and clear weather crew employed on discharge the oils.

Wednesday Sept 21 at Fayal with fine weather and clear we finished discharge the oils and stow the casks.

Thursday Sept 22 at Fayal with light wind and clear we take water on board.
