Lat 18° 50' S Long 34° 46' W

Wednesday December 7 This day strong breeze from NW and clear weather vessel under low sails running off steer SW by W. crew making sinnet pump attended to.

Lat 20° 50' S Long 34° 46' W

Thursday December 8 This day light wind from NW and rain vessel under all sails set on Port tack steer SW by W. at noon wind shifted to the West with rain and squalls we took in main sails set main try sails vessel head West pump attended to.

Lat 22° 00' S Long 35° 10' W

Friday December 9 This day light and calm, vessel under all sails set, on Starboard tack steer SW by W. at noon we raised a school of small whale, going quick to South we did not lower the boats was to far was pump attended to.

Lat 23° 11' S Long 36° 56' W

Saturday December 10 This day dead calm all day vessel under no sail set crew making sinnet pump attended to.

No observation

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Sunday December 11 This day fine and clear weather with light wind from NE, vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack steer SW by S. at noon we raised a large cow whale - we lowered three boats S.B. got him at 3:30 PM. we taking along side and we put gear up ready to cutting the next morning we shorting bails pump attended to.

Lat 23° 13' S Long 37° 45' W

Monday December 12 This day strong wind from NE and rough sea on at day light we commenced to cutting whale and we let the head go because the weather was bad at 2: PM we start the fire saw merchant man bound to West took gear down pump attended to.

Lat 23° 43' S Long 38° 10' W

Tuesday December 13 This day light wind from West and cloudy atmosphere vessel under main try sails and head sails, on Starboard tack, hailer saw a merchant man bound to South pump attended to.

No observation

Wednesday December 14 This day fresh West wind with clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack head SW by S. we finished boeking and stow the bails down at 7: PM the wind increased we took in main sails set main try sails pump attended to.
