Steu S.W. by South, we finished stowage down and wash the vessel in side, at 6:30 P.M. we raised a school of small whales, we did not lower the boat was to far and later, we shorting sails and leave to for the night pump attended to.

Sunday December 25 this day fresh breezes from N.E. with clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack running S.E. Steu S.W. saw a fin back. Pump attended to.

Lat 30° 20' S Long 46° 50' W

 Monday December 26 this day strong N.E. wind and clear atmosphere. Vessel under main topsails. Fore sails and head sails running. Steu W. by S. at 6: P.M. we raised a school of small whales going quick to the windward. we did not lower the boat at sun set we shorting sails Pump attended to.

Lat 31° 30' S Long 47° 55' W

 Tuesday December 27 this day fresh breezes from S.W. and cloudy weather. Vessel under all sails set on Port tack heading N.W. at 9: A.M. we raised a school of small whales we lower three boats we caught 4 small whales loses two and save ~~two~~ at 4: P.M. start to blow very hard with squally and heavy rain. S.B. was far way from the vessel left his whale and come on board, we put gear up ready to cutting the next morning. No observation.

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Wednesday December 28 this day moderate wind with clear weather in morning we start to cutting in whale, at 2: P.M. we finished cutting. Joaquim Silva, boatster, went up masthead to send cutting gear down, and he fall down on deck and injured very bad, and he die three hours afterwards, every body fell bad on board, at 6: P.M. wind blow hard with rain we did not start the fire pump, attended to. No observation sun oblique.

 Thursday December 29 this day very strong wind from S.E. with squall in morning we start the fire at noon we raised a school of small whale going to windward, we did not lower the boat at 6: P.M. we wore ship on Starboard tack at 4: clock P.M. we buried the body of Joaquim Silva, all of the crew feel very sorrowful. Pump attended to.

Lat 32° 27' S Long 48° 31' W

 Friday December 30 this day light S.E. wind and clear atmosphere, Vessel under main topsails, fore sail and head sails on Port tack heading S.W. at 7: P.M. we finished trailing. Some employed on repair the main sails. At 5: clock P.M. we raised a school of small whales going to windward we lower three but could not head them. At 2: the boat returned on board we shorting sails. Saw a whaling schooner to the forward suppose to be "John Manta". Pump attended to.

Lat 32° 29' S Long 49° 00' W
