on port tack steer ENE at 10 AM we
spoke to "Comes" she had 400 barrel rice
left Sagaf at 3:30 P.M. we raised a lone
whale going quick to windward we
did not lower the boats this went out
pump attended to
No observation

Sunday January 22 This day dead calm
vessel under shorting sails laying
around at 3 P.M. sprung up
light breeze from NE we made all
sails on port tack heading East
saw a fin back fish pump attended
to

with rough sea on vessel under fore
sails main top sails and head sails
on port tack head ENE crew unpacked
on repair the Lib and bend them on
pump attended to
Lat 28:14 S Long 38:34 W

Friday January 27 This day strong NW wind
with rough sea on vessel under main
trysails fore sails and head sails on
port tack steer ENE crew making sunset
pump attended to
Lat 27:50 S Long 36:55 W
