

Thursday March 2 This day light trade wind from NE and clear atmosphere. Vessel under all sails set on starboard tack steer NW by W. Crew employed on repair the sails pumps attended to
Lat 11:54 S Long 56:10 W

Friday March 3 This day fresh breeze from NE and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set on starboard tack steer NW by W. at noon we sighted the land about 40 miles off at 4 P.M. we shorting sails under lee of Barbados. - pumps attended to
No observation

Saturday March 4 This day light wind from NE and clear weather at 9 A.M. we came to anchor at Barbados, on 6 fathom water we star to work some carpenter and black smith, water pump attended to

Sunday March 5, at Barbados with fine weather one watch went shore and returned at noon, and the other went returned at night pumps attended to

Monday March 6, at Barbados with fine weather we sleep working with carpenter and black smith, take on board some fresh meat and sweet potatoes

Tuesday March 7 at Barbados with good weather we take on board sugar, Mellaces, and potatoes and Jam with carpenter and black smith and have the vessel ready to sea

Wednesday March 8 at 3:30 P.M. we sailed from Barbados with fine weather and fresh breeze, we made all sails on starboard tack steer NW by W. at 4:30 P.M. we set watch starboard watch. take first watch on deck pumps attended to
No observation

Thursday March 9 This day fresh breeze from the trade and clear vessel under all sails set on starboard tack steer NW by W. at day light we sighted the Martinique and Dominica - at 6 P.M. we shorting sails on the lee of Dominica. pumps attended to
No observation

Friday March 10 This day light wind with calm vessel under shorting cruising Dominica, in sight pumps attended to
No observation

Saturday March 11 This day very light breeze from the trade and clear weather - vessel under fore sails main by sail and jib cruising pumps attended to. We lower down for Black Fish we got 12 of them R-5 S-B-7 = taking board at 3:30 P.M. pumps attended to
Dominica in sight about 5 miles off

Sunday March 12 This day light wind from the trade and clear at noon we sighted a Black Fish we lower two traps we got 9 = R-B-4 S-B-5 = taken along side at 2:30 P.M. pumps attended to Dominica in sight
