Wednesday May 24 This day dead calm and clear atmosphere at 7:40 A.M. we raised a school of small whale we lower three boats we got 2 of them 20 B = at 10:30 A.M. we take the whale along side and put gear up start to cutting at 2 P.M. we finished cutting and took gear down and clear up the head start fire pump attended to
