trysails and fore staysails on Port tack

and main trysails standing on windward

and clear weather in morning we made
all sail on Port tack standing to South
at 1: A.M. we lower down for black fish
and we got 3 LB = 1 = 3 LB = 1 = W = 1 = at sun set

Thursday June 1 This day very light wind from
SE and clear atmosphere at day light
we made all sails on Starboard tack
at noon we wore ship standing to South
saw lots of porpoises and whales at
sun set shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 36:38 N Long 73:25 W

Friday June 2 This day very light NW wind with
calm in morning we made all sails on
Starboard tack heading NW saw lots of
porpoises at noon dead calm we took in
sails set trysails pump attended to
Lat 37:00 N Long 73:41 W

Saturday June 3 This day dead calm all day
vessel under no sails set at noon we
lower the boats for black fish we got
5 - LB = 2 - 3 LB = 1 - W = 2 - saw steamer bound
to Eastward, Pump attended to
Lat 37:07 N Long
