Monday June 12 This day gentle breeze from SE and clear atmosphere in morning we raised two whales cows & calf and we lower two boats and we struck two SP-Struck calf and foring after did sunk down at we take the other along side at 11:0 A.M. and we put gear up and we got dinner and start cutting in at 1:30 P.M. we finished cutting in and took gear down we stand to westward on Port tack, boiling at sun set we take in main sails set main top sails pump attended to

Tuesday June 13 This day fresh breeze from SW and foggy at day light we set main sails on Starboard tack heading SE at 7:30 A.M. we finished boiling and we set fore sails we stop down some oil, at sun set we shorting sails - pump attended to

Wednesday June 14 This day began with fresh breeze from West and clear in morning we made sails on Starboard tack head SSW. Saw a Whaling schooner to the South West of us and merchant man bound to SE at noon moderate wind we set main sails, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 37.40 N Long 71.35 W

Thursday June 15 This day began with fresh NW-Wind and clear weather in morning we made all sails on starboard tack heading south at 9:0 A.M. we wore ship and running off to Eastward at 11:30 P.M. we raised a school of small whale we lower three boats got one SP-take this whale along side at 3:0 P.M. - and we put gear up commec cutting in at 4 P.M. we finished and shorting (Sails pump) attended to

Lat 37.13 N Long 71.13 W

Friday June 16 This day fresh Westerly wind and clear weather in morning we made all sails on starboard tack heading SSW. Whaling Schooner in sight to the Northward of us and merchant man at noon wore ship to northward at 5 P.M. we start the fire and we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 37.38 N Long 70.48 W

Saturday June 17 This day light breeze from NW and clear with heavy swell from SE in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack heading WSW at 11:0 A.M. we raised a school of small whale, going quick to the windward we lower three boats but could not head them off and whale went out right boat returned on board hot sup dyed we have dinner at 6: P.M. we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 37.45 N Long 70.50 W
