Thursday July 5 This day began with light SW wind and clear atmosphere, in morning we made all sails on Port tack standing to the South in company with "Nickelson" at 7 A.M. we raised a school of small whale we lower 3 boats "Nickerson" also lower three boats we caught 2 small whale, S.B.-1-W.B.-1- we take this whale along side at noon - and we put gear, commence to cutting at 5 P.M. we finished cutting and clear up the head and start fire at sun set we shorting sails, pumps attended to

Lat 37° 05' N Long 73° 19' W

Thursday July 6 This day began with light SW wind and clear weather at day light we set main sails on Starboard tack standing to South East at 6:00 A.M. we raised a school of small whale going quick to the Westward we lower two boats can't head them off but returned on board at 9:00 P.M. we finished hauling 4, schooner in sight and bark at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Friday July 7 This day began with light SW wind and clear weather vessel under all sails, set on Starboard tack cruising 4 Whaling Schooner in sight at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Saturday July 8 This day began with very light SW wind and clear atmosphere we made all sails in morning standing to the South on Starboard tack at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Lat 36° 55' N Long 73° 00' W

Saw a School of Small whale lower three boats did not get any

Sunday July 9 This day light SW wind and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising other vessel went out sight fore SW wind from us at sun set we shorting sails saw lots of porpoises pumps attended to

Lat 36° 48' N Long 72° 40' W

Monday July 10 This day fresh SW wind and foggy in morning we raised a school of small whale we lower three boats whale start to the Westward the boats returned on board we hoist up and standing to South saw lots of porpoises at sun set we shorting sails and wore ship to the Westward

Lat 36° 55' N Long 73° 12' W

Tuesday July 11 This day fresh breeze from SE and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Port tack cruising saw lots of porpoises at sun set we shorting sails pumps attended to

Lat 36° 58' N Long 73° 04' W

Wednesday July 12 This day very light wind from SW and clear vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack heading South saw lots of porpoises crew making sennet pumps attended to

Lat 36° 57' N Long 73° 39' W

Thursday July 13 This day light SW wind and clear atmosphere in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack standing to the South
