We spoke to Manta, and the Capt

pump attended to

Saturday May 11 this day began with very
light SE wind and clear weather
at day light we made all sails
on Port tack standing to West
at 7:30 A.M. saw a Swift and Nickelson
we hoists down Swift got a small
whale at 5:30 P.M. we raised a
school of small whale we lower
three boats & caught 2-3 B-1-W B-4-
take the whale along side at 8: AM
and shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 31.40 N Long 72.35 W
Sunday May 12 this day very strong wind
from SE and cloudy with rough
sea on at 5 A.M. we commence plugging
at noon we finished and took gear
down and clear up the hold -
a m Nickelson in sight at 6: A.M.
pump attended to

Monday May 13 this day strong S West wind
and cloudy vessel under two topsail
and fib on Starboard tack, "Manta" in sight at 5 P.M. wind shift to NW
with clear atmosphere Pump attend
ed to No observation

Tuesday May 14 this day light NW wind
and clear in morning we start fire
at 5: P.M. we gave with Manta
at sun set shorting sails at 10 P.M.
finished boiling pump attended to
Lat 31.33 N Long 72.58 W

Wednesday May 15 this day strong SE wind
with squall and rain vessel under
two topsails and fore staysails standing
on windward on Starboard tack
"Manta" in sight pump atten
ded to Lat 31.42 N Long 72.58 W

Thursday May 16 this day fresh breeze from
SE and clear vessel under two
topsails and fib standing on wind
ward John Manta in sight crew
employed on wash the vessel in
side pump attended to
No observation

Friday May 17 this day moderate wind
from SE vessel under all sails set
on Port tack, saw lots of porpoises
"Manta" in sight, at sun set we shorting
sails pump attended to
Lat 31.50 N Long 72.51 W

Saturday May 18 this day light Westerly wind
at day light we made all sails on
Starboard tack "Manta" in sight saw lots of
porpoises, at sun set we shorting sails
pump attended to
Lat 31.36 N Long 73.01 W
