Thursday August 8 this day fresh breezes from SW and clear weather in morning we made all sails on Starboard tack head South at 7:4 A.M. we raised a large whale we lower three boats and we got him W.B. taking along side at 8 A.M. put gears up ready to cutting the water morning we shorting sails pump attended to

Friday August 9 this day fresh SW wind with rough sea at day light we start cutting whale fat 4 PM we finished cutting and we lose the eased chain bust pump attended to at 6:0 PM we start fire

Saturday August 10 this day fresh breezes from NE with rain vessel under shorting sails on port tack, boiling pump attended to

Lat 36:24 N Long 41:54 W

At 6:30 P.M. Raised a large whale - going NE - did not touch the boat was later

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Sunday August 11 this day very light NE wind with rain in morning vessel under main tryails and fib on Port tack boiling - pump attended to

Lat 36:06 N Long 42:06 W

Monday August 12 this day light NE wind and cloudy with rain vessel under two tryails and fib on port tack heading E.S.E. pump attended to

Lat 35:58 N Long 42:35 W

Tuesday August 13 this day fresh breezes from NE with great swell from North vessel under shorting sails on port tack heading E.S.E. crew making repair pump attended to

Lat 35:45 N Long 42:18 W

Wednesday August 14 this day fresh NE wind with clear atmosphere vessel under shorting sails on port tack head East some for porpoises pump attended to

Lat 35:40 N Long 41:14 W

Thursday August 15 this day dead calm with very light NE wind vessel under main tryails fore sails and fib on port tack we stow down some sails at sun set we taking fore sails set fore tryails pump attended to

Lat 35:35 N Long 40:54 W

Observed several porpoises
