Saturday Dec 21 this day fresh SW wind with clear atmosphere Vessel under reef topsails on Port tack heading NW by W. "S. Sower" in sight. Saw merchant bark bound to NE pump attended to

Sunday December 22 this day light NW wind and clear atmosphere, Vessel under all sails set cruising. Saw a Grampus at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday December 23 First part of this day moderate NE wind, later part very strong with rough sea on Vessel under shorting sail on Starboard tack head NW at 6: P.M. we raised a large whale did not lower the boats, pump attended to

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Tuesday December 24 this day strong NE wind with rough sea on Vessel under two topsails and set on port tack at 11: A.M. we raised a school of small whale going quick to Windward we did not lower the boats pump attended to

Wednesday December 25 this day moderate wind from NE and foggy Vessel under shorting sails on port tack Capt finished repair the boat pump attended to

Lat 33:15 S Long 47:45 W

Thursday December 26 This day light wind from NE and clear atmosphere Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack head NW. Saw a Grampus, we put Starboard boat on their place at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat 33:14 S Long 48:26 W

Friday December 27 this day light NE wind and clear weather. In morning we made all sails on Starboard tack, at noon we raised a two large whale going to Windward, we kept two boats and S.B. struck one of them and we take the whale alongside at 4 P.M. and we put goats up ready to cutting. Next morning we shorting sails pump attended to
