Monday Dec. 30 This day moderate wind from SE and clear weather Vessel under two try sails and fil on Port tack at 2.30 P.M. we finished boiling at 4 P.M. we spout to "T. Towner" pump attended to

Tuesday Dec. 31 This day strong SW wind and clear weather Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack "T. Towner" in sight in morning at noon she went out sight, pump attended to

Friday January 3 This day very light NE wind with calm Vessel under two try sails and fil on Starboard tack Saw a Grampus "Alice Knowles" went out of sight at noon to Southward pump attended to

Saturday January 4 This day fresh breeze from NE and clear atmosphere Vessel under shorting sails on Starboard tack made NW at 7.30 P.M. Francisco Silva (Steward) die = and we buried him at 11 P.M. all on board fill very sorry pump attended to
