Tuesday January 7 This day moderate wind from SW and clear atmosphere vessel under low sails on Starboard tack running off 2 Steers by South "I. Towner" in sight at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat. 32:27 S Long 47:43 W

Wednesday January 8 This day calm with light SW wind in morning we raised a school of small whale we lower three boats, did not get any whale going quick boats returned on board we hoist up "I. Towner" got a small whale at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Lat. 32:26 S Long 47:27 W

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Thursday January 9 This day moderate wind from SW and clear atmosphere vessel under foresails main topsails and head sails on Starboard tack at 9:40 AM we raised a school of small whale and a large whale going quick we could not head them off at 5:30 PM raised a school of small whale to the leeward we lower three boats can not get near them the boats returned on board at dark we shorting sails pump attended to

Friday January 10 This day fresh breezes from NE and clear atmosphere vessel under shorting sails on port tack saw a Fin back at 6:30 AM we sighted the "I. Towner" pump attended to

Lat. 32:10 S Long 46:33 W

Saturday January 11 This day fresh breezes from NW and clear weather vessel under shorting sails on port tack "I. Towner" in sight saw black fish - pump attended to

Lat. 32:12 S Long 46:35 W

Sunday - Monday January 12 This day calm with light wind from SW we made all sails on port tack head NW at noon breeze up strong we shorting sails - pump attended to

Lat. 32:45 S Long 47:04 W

Monday January 13 This day dead calm vessel under two topsails - saw a Grampus and a Schooner to leeward supposed to be "Cameo" pump attended to
