Wednesday May 28 this day fresh breeze from SE and clear Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack head SE at 3:30 PM we raised a school of large whale we lower three boats the "Wanderer" lower 4 boats the whale group quick to the fore and the boats returned on board.

at 8 PM we went with Wanderer with 219 barrels
