Wednesday July 2 this day fresh breezes from SW and squally with rain. Vessel under two trysails and jib on port tack head NW. Saw a Grampus. pump attended to. No observation.

Thursday July 3 this day strong breezes from SW and squally at 8 A.M. we raised a school of small whale we lower two boats whale going quick to windward boats returned on board. pump attended to. No observation.

Friday July 4 this day strong breezes from SW and squall all day at 10 P.M. we raised a school of whale we lower two boats (3 Boat) capsized and we lower W Boat to pick him up and save everything. L.B. struck a small whale and we taking along side at 3 P.M. and we have to cutting nocturnal day - rain all afternoon pump attended to. No observation.
