Lat $37^{\circ} 36'$ Long $73^{\circ} 23' W$

Saturday May 16 this day dead calm vessel under no sails set crew making pennet pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ} 25' N$ Long $73^{\circ} 28' W$

Sunday May 17 this day light wind from NE and clear atmosphere vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack running off at sea set we shorting sails pump attended to saw a Whaling schooner to the leeward of us looking pump attended to
No observation

Monday May 18 this day very light wind from the SW and cloudy vessel under all sails set cruising at sea set we shorting sails pump attended to
No observation

Tuesday May 19 this day light wind from NE and clear atmosphere at day light we made all sails on Starboard tack cruising in company with "manta" at 5 P.M. the manta went out of sight set sea set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $36^{\circ} 50' N$ Long $74^{\circ} 03' W$

Wednesday May 20 this day fresh breeze from NE and foggy vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising at sea down we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ} 00' N$ Long $74^{\circ} 04' W$

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Thursday May 21 - this day light northerly wind and foggy vessel under all sails set cruising at 8 A.M. we raised a school of 3 small whales we lower three boats and 2 small whales and we took along side at noon and we start cutting at 4 P.M. we finished and start the fire and shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ} 05' N$ Long $73^{\circ} 39' W$

Friday May 22 this day calm with thick fog vessel under staysails - pump we finished looking pump attended to
No observation

Saturday May 23 this day light wind from NW at day light we made all sails cruising saw lots of Stamer bound to Eastward at sea set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ} 30' N$ Long $73^{\circ} 02' W$

Sunday May 24 this day moderate NE wind and cloudy vessel under all sails set on port tack cruising at sea set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ} 53' N$ Long $72^{\circ} 55' W$

Monday May 25 this day light SE wind and clear weather vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising pump attended to
Lat $38^{\circ} 04' N$ Long $72^{\circ} 41' W$

Tuesday May 26 this day fresh breeze from SW foggy vessel under shorting sails cruising - spoke "Graber" "Swift" in sight Lat $37^{\circ} 49' N$ Long $72^{\circ} 00' W$
