Thursday May 28 this day light westerly wind and clear weather vessel under all sails set cruising "Graber and Swift" in sight at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}48'N$ Long $72^{\circ}34'W$

Friday May 29 this day strong breeze from the NE and clear weather at daylight we made sails on Starboard tack head NW at 9 A.M. saw the "Graber" with boats down for whales, and she caught 2 small ones we did not lose the boats "Swift" in sight at noon we running off to the westward at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $38^{\circ}2'N$ Long $72^{\circ}34'W$

Saturday May 30 this day fresh breeze from SW and and foggy in morning we made all sail on Starboard tack head South at 7 P.M. we raised a school of small whales, and we did not lower the boats was too later we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}46'N$ Long $73^{\circ}35'$

Sunday May 31 this day light wind from SW and clear weather vessel under all sails set cruising saw the Steamer bound to South and North at noon we came to "Swift" at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}17'S$ Long $74^{\circ}12'W$

Monday May June 1 this day first part very light wind from NE and clear at day light we raised a school of small whales we lower three boats with "Swift" our boat got a small bull whale taken along side at noon and we cutting and start fire and shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}18'N$ Long $73^{\circ}54'W$

Tuesday June 2 this day strong breeze from the NE and rough sea on vessel under shorting sails cruising at 4 P.M. the "Swift" got a small whale we did not lower the boats was too far to leeward pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}18'N$ Long $73^{\circ}18'W$

Wednesday June 3 this day very light wind from NE and cloudy vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising at 6 A.M. we raised 3 bull whales we lower three boats and "Swift" went on the whale the boatmen lost the iron did not get fast from land but did not went true, "Swift" in sight also lower three boats and struck one of them the rest went out of sight and the boats returned on board at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}08'N$ Long $73^{\circ}43'W$

Thursday June 4 this day very strong wind from SW and atmosphere rough vessel under shorting sails cruising at 8 P.M. we raised a lot of white water going to windward "Elena Swift" in sight at noon we raised a school of small whales going to windward we lower three boats "Swift" also lower two boats we caught one S.B. and short on we cutting before night shorting sails

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Friday June 5 this day strong breeze from the NE and clear at day light we raised a school of small whales we lower three boats with "Swift" our boat got a small bull whale taken along side at noon and we cutting and start fire and shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}18'N$ Long $73^{\circ}54'W$

Saturday June 6 this day strong breeze from the NE and rough sea on vessel under shorting sails cruising at 4 P.M. the "Swift" got a small whale we did not lower the boats was too far to leeward pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}18'N$ Long $73^{\circ}18'W$

Sunday June 7 this day very light wind from NE and cloudy vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack cruising at 6 A.M. we raised 3 bull whales we lower three boats and "Swift" went on the whale the boatmen lost the iron did not get fast from land but did not went true, "Swift" in sight also lower three boats and struck one of them the rest went out of sight and the boats returned on board at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat $37^{\circ}08'N$ Long $73^{\circ}43'W$
