Towner in sight to leeward of us at 4 PM we raised school of Small whale we lower three boats SB struck a small whale, and LB had whale missed and SB also had whale missed, we take this whale along side at 6 PM and have gear ready for next morning pump attended to

Sunday July 5 this day fresh breeze from NE and squally vessel under shorting sail looking for "Graber" and "Swift" in sight at 11 AM "Graber" and "Swift" raised a school of Small whale, Graber got one "Swift" didn't get one we did not lower the boats pump attended to

Monday July 6 this day very strong wind from NE and haze squally still rain vessel under two trysails on Starboard tack "Swift" in sight to the leeward pump attended to

Tuesday July 7 this day light wind from west and clear weather in morning we made all sails and cruising "Swift" and "Graber" in sight to windward at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Wednesday July 8 this day calm with rain squally vessel under trysails "Swift" went out of sight pump attended to

Thursday July 9 this day began with with fresh NE wind and later part calm we shorting sails pump attended to

Friday July 10 this day began with calm and foggy vessel under two trysails lay around. Sake lots of grampes pump attended to

Saturday July 11 this day began with very light SW wind and haze vessel under all sail set cruising at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Sunday July 12 this day light SW wind and clear weather vessel under all sails set cruising saw a Whaling schooner to the leeward at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to

Monday July 13 this day fresh breeze from SW and foggy vessel under shorting sails saw lots of porpoise and Grampes pump attended to
