Lat 37.10 Long 73.48 W

Friday July 17 this day strong SW wind with
rough sea on vessel under under
two topsails and fit standing on Windward
on Port tack pump attended to
Lat 37.09 Long 74.25 W

Saturday July 18 this day moderate SW Wind
in morning we made all sails
on Starboard tack cruising whole
fleet in sight at sun set we shorting
sails pump attended to
Lat 36.50 N Long 73.32 W

Sunday July 19 this day very light wind
from NW and clear weather in
morning we raised a School of Small
Whales we lower three boats caught

7 PM Shorting sails

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Monday July 20 this day light wind from
NE and clear vessel under main sails
and head sails boiling at 8 AM the
Towner raised a School of Small
Whales we lower two boats don't get
any boats returned on board

large whale to the leeward at sun set we
shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 36.48 N Long 74.04 W

Wed. July 22 this day very light wind from
SE and hazy at day light we made all
sails cruising three Schooner in sight
at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 36.55 N Long 74.00

Thursday July 23 this day first part calm and
later part fresh breeze from SE and
rough sea on in morning vessel raised
a large Whale, we lower three boats
we lower three boats T. Towner also
lower three boats and SW got him
mate with T. Towner at sun set we
shorting sails pump attended to
Lat 37.10 N Long 73.74 W

Friday July 24 this day light wind from NW
atmosphere hazy vessel under two sails
cruising Drabber in sight we came
to Drabber in after noon pump attended to
Lat 36.58 N Long 73.51 W
