Monday August 3 this day strong SW Wind
Clear Weather sunset under shorting
sails on port tack at sun set squally
SWill and moderate wind vessel taken
Some pumps attended to
Lat 37° 40' Long 73° 24' W

Tuesday August 4 this day very light SW
Wind and cloudy in morning we
made all sails on port tack head W
at 4 P.M. we shorting sails wind
shift to SE with rain and foggy
we wore ship on Starboard tack
pumps attended to
Lat 37° 17' N Long 73° 34' W

Wednesday August 5 this day light wind from
the NE and clear weather in morning
we made all sails on port tack at
11 A.M. we gave "Graber" at sun set
we shorten sails pumps attended to
Lat 37° 09' N Long 73° 56' W

Thursday August 6 this day strong breeze from
SW Squally with rain at day light
we raised a school of small whales
we lower three boats and L.B. struck
a small whale, and stow the boat
but we save the whale taken along side
at noon and we put gear up of comm
to cutting at 2 P.M. we finished cutting
we did not start the fire in account of
rain pumps attended to
"Graber" in sight
Lat 37° 10' N Long 73° 55' W

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Friday August 7 this day Dead calm in
Morning saw a Graber with boats down
Chasing Whales we lower three boats could
not head them off the boats returned on
board and Whales went out sight
pumps attended to
Lat 37° 15' N Long 73° 55' W

Saturday August 8 this day light wind from SW
and clear atmosphere in morning
we raised a school of young bulls
and we lower three boats caught one
L.B. taking along side at noon and
we cutting in head start fire
at 3 P.M. we raised an
other school of small whales we
lower three boats caught two small
Whales L.B. = 1 - W = 1 - take along side
at 4:30 P.M. and we shorting sails
pumps attended to
Lat 37° 07' N Long 74° 8' W

Sunday August 9 this day moderate wind
from SW and clear weather in morning
we made sails on Starboard tack wif
company with "Swift" at 7:30 A.M. we
saw a school of small whales
we lower three we also lower three boats
"Swift" caught small whale we did not get
any boats returned on board we shorting
sails pumps attended to
Lat 37° 19' N Long 73° 50' W

Monday August 10 this day fresh breeze from SW and
clear weather in morning we made all
sails on Starboard tack crossing "Swift"
and "Graber" in sight at sun set we
shorting sails pumps attended to
Lat 37° 21' N Long 73° 05' W
