

Remarks on the board schooner C.B

June

June 11th 1916 This day began with light breeze and big swell. Employed cutting the three whales and clear up the heads get supper and set the watch. Pumps & side light - Carefully attended. end of day. (Lat: 34.18 N.) (Lon: 48.32 W.)

June

June 12th 1916 This day light breeze and fine clear weather wind from SW ship on short sails. Watch Employed try out & stored down some oil saw nothing. pumps & side light - Carefully attended. end of day. (Lat: 34.12 N.) (Lon: 48.35 W.)

June

June 13th 1916 This day steady breeze and fine clear weather wind from SW. At 6.40 am D. Henry shot saw school of whales drop down the boat. Mr. Perry struck one Mr. Rincon struck two lost one came aboard cutting the 2 whales and sent down the gears. & stored down some oil try out same time. Saw 3 whales to the E of us aft. end of day (Lat: 34.36 N.) (Lon: 48.16 W.)

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Wed:

June 14th 1916 This day strong breeze and clear weather wind from SW. Ship on short sails. Employed finish try out and stored down 122 barrel. Saw two steamer bound S & Master bound to the island. end of day. (Lat: 34.44 N.) (Lon: 47.55 W.)

June

Thurs: 15th 1916

This day strong breeze and clear weather wind from SW. Ship laying on short sails on starboard tack. Watch Employed on ship duty. Saw nothing pumps & side light - Carefully attended. end of day. (Lat: 34.12 N.) (Lon: 47.03 W.)

June

Frid: 16th 1916

This day belawing gale wind and high sea wind from SW. Ship laying on small sails on starboard tack. Ship making lots water pumping every two hrs. Saw nothing end of day. (Lat: 33.33 N.) (Lon: 46.24 W.)

June

Sat: 17th 1916

This day calm all day & high sea ship heaving very heavy. Pumps Carefully attended. Saw some grampas end of day. (Lat: 33.53 N.) (Lon: 46.49 W.)

Sun:

June 18th 1916

This day strong breeze and high sea wind from NE ship on short sail saw nothing. pumps & side light - Carefully attended. end of day. (Lat: 34.00 N.) (Lon: 47.19 W.)
