June
Mon: 19th: 1916 This day fresh breeze and clear weather. Wind from NE all sails set. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.30 N. Lon: 48.54 W.)

June
Tues: 20th: 1916 This day fresh breeze and clear weather. Wind from SE. Ship on small sail. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.13 N. Lon: 48.54 W.)

June
Wed: 21st: 1916 This day light breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from SE. all sails set. Saw black fish and grampas. at 7 o'clock take on mainsail and light sail. Course SE. Watch employed on ship duty. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.03 N. Lon: 48.47 W.)

June
Thurs: 22nd: 1916 This day steady breeze and fine weather. Wind from SW. Course SE by E all sails set. at 3.50 p.m. Mr. Vansant saw school of whales to windward drop down the boat pool to windward and whale came to the ship by the time the boat came to the ship was too late don't get any. Short down & let lay. end of day. (Lat: 34.20 N. Lon: 49.16 W.)

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June
Fri: 23rd: 1916 This day began with strong wind and squally with rain p.m. strong breeze and clear weather. Wind from SW. Ship on small sail. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.21 N. Lon: 47.14 W.)

June
Sat: 24th: 1916 This day began with strong breeze and clear weather. Wind from S at 11 a.m. light breeze set all sails. Saw Barque bound to SE. at 7 o'clock taking the sails. Watch employed on ship duty. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.15 N. Lon: 46.14 W.)

June
Sun: 25th: 1916 This day began with strong breeze and clear weather. Wind from S at 10 a.m. light breeze set all the sails. Saw five whaler. Choocher bound to SE. at 7 o'clock taking on mainsail & flying jib. Wore ship to the SW. tack. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.17 N. Lon: 45.24 W.)

June
Mon: 26th: 1916 This day steady breeze and hazy weather. Wind from S. all sails set. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. at 7 o'clock wore ship & taking on the sails. Pump & Side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34.10 N. Lon: 44.33 W.)
