July
Wed: 5th 1916 This day calm all day & clear weather. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. pumps & side light carefully attended. End of day.

July
Thurs: 6th 1916 This day calm all day & clear weather. Saw nothing but Gramps & proper. Watch employed on ship duty. ~~at~~ at 2:30 p.m. drop down the boat pick up a drum & cut 2 dozen pump & side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 32° 50' N. Lon: 44° 18' W)

July
Frid: 7th 1916 This day light breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from E all sails set. at 3:05 p.m. Mr. Vincent saw a large whale long ways to windward drop down the boat but don't get it. Came aboard taking on the sails but landed on starboard tack. pumps & side light - carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 33° 30' N. Lon: 44° 47' W) 

July
Sat: 8th 1916 This day steady breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from E all sails set. Saw nothing but fog and got it long side cut some fish. Saw steamer bound W. at 7 o'clock short her down to try sails let her lay on port tack. end of day. (Lat: 33° 34' N. Lon: 44° 38' W)

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July
Sun: 9th 1916 This day steady breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from E all sails set at 7 o'clock short her down to try sails let her lay on starboard tack. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. pumps & side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 33° 30' N. Lon: 44° 24' W)

July
Mon: 10th 1916 p.m. light breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from E all sails set. Saw nothing. Watch employed on ship duty. pumps & side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34° 00' N. Lon: 44° 40' W)

July
Tues: 11th 1916 p.m. light breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. at 3:05 p.m. Mr. Vincent saw large whale drop down the boat but killers had him wild do not get it. Saw steamer bound W. pumps and side light carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 34° 24' N. Lon: 44° 40' W) 

July
Wed: 12th 1916 This day light breeze and fine clear weather. Wind from SE lat. 5:10 a.m. Thru. Alut saw large whale drop the boat coast all day don't get it at 7 o'clock short her down to try sails let her lay. end of day. (Lat: 34° 13' N. Lon: 45° 04' W)
