

Remarks On Board of the

Saturday February the 1st 1845
First part of this day Strong Winds from the N.W. heading, N.W. at 7 A.M. set the fore & main topsails & S.P. to take them in again & at 6 Sent Down the fore & main topsails & galant yards it being a gale of Wind & cloudy & rainy heavy small several seas Breeze put on the foremast & main to the main topsails & a solid lashing on the both galy, middle part the same latter part the same moderate so end the day.

Sunday February the 2nd 1845
First part of the day Breeze a gale of Wind from W. heading, N. at 4 A.M. for moderate set the fore & main topsails then being blast reefed at 9 A.M. & hauled out the reefs out & set the flying Jib & Mast up to the mast head. Looking out for Whales saw six Backs & Sulphur Bottoms & porpoises & broke out Molasses under parts the same & Scatter Double Reefed the topsails & furl'd the Main sail equally & rainy so end the day.

Monday Feb the 3rd 1845
First part of this day Strong Winds from W. heading, S.W. under Double reefed topsails at 4 A.M. hauled the reefs out at 7 set the Main top galant sail & flying Jib & at 6 P.M. looked the Main top galant sail & Double reefed the topsails latter part when the Main topsail & Close reefed fore & main topsail it Breeze heavy so end the day.

Tuesday Feb the 4th 1845
First part of this day Strong Winds from S.W. lowers N.W. by W at 4 A.M. hauled out the reefs & at 5 Double reefed them again & at 7 Close reefed the topsails & reefed the mainsail & at 10 furl'd the fore & main topsails & at 11 furl'd the mainsail Middle part Wind from W. heading S.W. Breeze a strong gale of Wind latter part the same so end the day.

Wednesday Feb the 5th 1845
First part of this day Strong Winds from the S.W. heading N.W. at 1 A.M. set the fore topsail & at 2 set the Main & at 3 hauled out reef of the topsails & set the Jib & at 5 hauled out the reefs out of the fore topsail & set the Main top galant sail Middle part the same at 8 took in the Main top galant sail & Double reefed the topsails & at 12 Close reefed the topsails & furl'd the Main sail at 2 A.M. furl'd the fore & main topsails & Breeze a gale of Wind lying to under blast. Reefed Main topsail & furl'd the Main sail latter part the same.

Thursday Feb the 6th 1845
First part of this day Breeze a gale from W. heading, S.W. at 7 A.M. set the fore sail & reefed it & at 9 reefed the main sail & set it & at 11 Close the main topsail at 12 set the fore & main topsails the same at 1 P.M. or thereabouts ship standing to the N. heading, N.W. under blast reefed topsails & reefed main sail latter part the same 1 man sick below a Nigger so end the day.

Friday Feb the 7th 1845
First part of this day Breeze Strong Winds from the W. heading N.W. under Close reefed topsails & reefed Main sail at 3.30 took in the fore & main topsails & hauled up the boards it being squally at 5 A.M. set the fore & main topsails & at 7 set the Main topsail & a N. heading at 8 P.M. reefed the fore sail equally & lying to day Middle & latter part the same so end the day.

Saturday Feb the 8th 1845
First part of this day Strong Winds from the W. heading N.W. under Close reefed topsails Reefed main sail at 9 A.M. Wave ship standing W. S.W. Breeze heavy small & rainy Middle part the same latter part hauled out the reefs & set the fore & main topsails Wind moderate so end the day.
