Remarks On Board of the Ship

Monday May the 3. D. 1842
First parts of this day Moderate Winds from the N.E. by E. With all Drawing sail set Watch employed in braking out for Water Middle parts the same & latter parts finished braking & stode off. Again so ends the day of 24 hours

Tuesday May 6 the D. 1842
First parts of this day Moderate Winds from the N.E. by E. With all possible sail set Middle parts the same Watch employed in picking over potatoes & at 6 P.M. fine backs to the Leeward latter parts ends the same

Wednesday May 7 the D. 1842
First parts of this day Light Winds from the E. by S. With all possible sail set in picking a burden Middle parts Heavy Weather with some rain & latter parts Strong Winds from the E. by S. & ends the day

Thursday May 8 the
First parts of this day Strong Winds from the S.E. by E. With all possible sail set Middle parts Light Winds & haze Watch employed in Ship's Duty toward Down the West Port Boat to try how the cars would peck latter parts the same So ends the day much the same

Friday May 9 the D.
First parts of this day Light Winds from N.E. by E. With all possible sail set Middle parts the same & latter parts Rainy from N.E. by E. with 2 goats so ends the day Saw 2 fine backs

Saturday May the 10.
First parts of this day Strong Winds from the N.E. by E. With all possible sail set Watch employed in mending the sails Cloudy & shower of rain

Saturday May 10 the Continue
Capt King employed in painting the boats. Middle parts the same Run the West Port Line & latter parts calm among below decks so ends the day

Sunday May 11 the D. 1842
First parts of this day Light Winds from the N.E. by E. With all possible sail set Middle parts the same & at 5 P.M. saw jumpto the Leeward latter parts Light Winds so ends the day

Monday May 12 the
First parts of this day Light Winds from the E. by S. With all possible sail set at 6 A.M. saw fine backs to the Leeward Watch employed in Ship's Duty Middle parts the same Cloudy & haze Saw some porpoises & fine backs latter parts the same so ends the day of 24 hours

Tuesday May 13 the
First parts of this day Light Winds from the E. by S. With all possible sail set at 4 A.M. Ship to the N. heading W. At 5 P.M. in the fore galant sails Watch employed in braking out for Middle parts the same & at 10 A.M. set the galant sails again latter parts strong Winds & cloudy ends the day

Wednesday May 14 D.
First parts of this day Light Winds from N.E. by E. With all possible sail set Middle parts the same & at 10 A.M. set the galant sails again latter parts strong Winds & cloudy ends the day

Thursday May 15 the
First parts of this day Light Winds from the S. by E. With all possible sail set Middle parts the same & at 10 A.M. set the galant sails again latter parts strong Winds & cloudy ends the day of 24 hours
