

Remarks On Board of The

Friday May 16th

First part of this day strong breeze from the S.W. bore N by W at 4 A.M. took in the standing sail & sent down the boom. Raining & foggy took in top galant sails. Mr. Triggs & John & myself is employed in making a pig pen & latter part mended the main top galant sail & set it so ends the day foggy & raining

Saturday May 17th D 1845

First part of this day strong breeze from the S.W. bore N.W. at 1 & sent down the fore & J. Sail to mend & sent up the fore topmast standing sail. Heavy foggy & heavy showers of rain middle part the same latter part mended the fore & J. sail & set it up so ends the day squally

Sunday May 18th

First part of this day strong winds from W.S.W. bore N.W. at 10 A.M. took in & set the top galant sail several times. Middle part the same squally & raining & latter part double reefed the topsails & at 1 P.M. took in the main topsails so ends the day hazy & wet

Monday May 19th

First part of this day strong winds from the N.W. bore N.W. at 2 A.M. set the main topsails & at day light turned out the reefs & set the M. S. I. sail middle part the same & at 5 P.M. set the fore topmast standing sail latter part squally so ends the day

Tuesday May 20th

First part of this day strong winds from the N.W. bore N.W. at 10 A.M. sent down the fore & J. sail & sent in the fore to mend & hoist & reefed the topsails so ends the day

Ship Cassander of Providence

Wednesday May 21st

First part of this day strong winds from the W.W. bore N.W. at 10 A.M. took in the fore & main topsails & hauled the main sail down. Quarter watches middle part the same & latter part set the topsails & mainsail equal of hail & rain so ends the day

Thursday May 22nd

First part of this day strong winds from the W. bearing N.W. & main top sails & sent out the fore to mend & sent down the back light sails middle part the same & at 11 A.M. set top galant sails & at sunset set fore topmast standing sail latter part took in & reefed the fore topsail & hauled main I. so ends the day & foggy

Friday May 23rd D 1845

First part of this day strong winds from the W. bore N.W. at 10 A.M. under clost reefed fore sail & hauled the mainsail middle part the same & at quarter watches so ends the day & foggy & rainy

Saturday May 24th

First strong winds from the W.S.W. bore N.W. at day light made sail & sent down the back & at 1 sent a right whale towards 3 boats without success. Boat boats line got exposed in getting it in middle part the same at sunset took in sail. Brought hard & at 11 P.M. took in the fore sail & hoist & reefed the main topsail. Brought a strong gale from the S.W. latter part ends the same
