

Remarks On Board the

Monday Nov. 24. th D 1845
First part of this day begins with light winds
from the S.E. & course S.W. with all
possible sail set saw five backs & grampuses
middle part the same & latter part wind
from N.E. by N. course S.S.W. so ends the day
Lat 4.30. N

Tuesday Nov 25th
First part of this day, commences with moderate
winds from the S.E. by E course S.S.W. all day
sail made part the same watch employed
in fishing (beginning & saw nothing)
Latter part the same winds the day
Lat 3.03. N

Wednesday Nov 26th
First part of this day light winds from
S.E. course S.W. with all possible sail set
saw porpoises watch employed in mending sail
middle part the same & latter part
the same so ends the day
1 sail in sight Lat 1.41. N

Thursday Nov 27th D 1845
First part of this day begins with
moderate winds from S.E. & course S.W.
watch employed in backing out water
middle part the same latter part
squally so ends the day
Lat 0.41. P Long 158

Friday Nov 28th
This day begins with light winds from
S.E. & course S.W. with all possible sail watch
employed in mending sails bent a B. Sail
middle part the same at 6 A.M. spoke the
Bague Harriet of Proctor 16 months 1000
No. so ends the day Lat 0.9. South Long 160. E

Saturday Nov 29th D 1845
This day begins with moderate winds from
S.E. & course S.S.W. watch employed in mending
mizen topsail & other old sails middle part
the same & latter part the same
1 sail in sight so ends the day
Lat 1.12. S Long 160.25. East

Sunday Nov 30th
This day begins with light winds
saw a school of sperm whales lowered
got 2 the B.B. & L.B. & the school got galed
the S. Boat & coast Boat pursued chase
i. Danted 3 times at slits, chasers got in
in 1 whale & the other in another boat
in the small line were brought boat he
came out capt ~~tried~~ tried to make
out any better gave up the chase
went a to the ship cut in the whales
& a P.M. saw them again lowered
the boats the Whist boat pursued &
quit stone the still bound fastened to
another capt King hill on line & I named
the craft it being black the Subjean
Boat pursued & cut got 2000 lbs whale
to the ship so ends

Monday Nov December the 1st
this day cutting in we got through
saw 1 whale I lowered the boats the
B.L. Boat pursued & horse boat to
struck stone the horse boat me heide
to pick them up for minstow
took the whale to the ship
& cut him in
so ends the day
