

Remarks onboard of Bark Catalpa
14 Sunday July 6

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather and a strong wind match employed in various jobs Middle part pleasant latter part the same course steering E S E Middle part So ends these 24 hours

Latitude 36° 02' Long

15 Monday July 7

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather course E by S at sundown commenced raining tacked ship heading S Middle part squally steering by the wind heading N E Latter part pleasant with a strong wind broke out the main hatchway for water So ends

Latitude 38° 12' N Long 45° 29' W

16 Tuesday July 8

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather steering by the wind heading N E the match employed in stowing off the main hatchway Middle part squally steering S S E Latter part squally the match employed in packing out the fore hole for various things So ends

Latitude 37° 42' Long 44° 18'

17 Wednesday Thursday July 9th

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather steering by the wind heading S by E the match employed in stowing off the fore hole took in the fore and main gallant sail and gaff topsail Middle part light wind made all sail at daylight and sail off the weather quarter employed in various jobs 2 sails insight So ends

Lat 36° 48' N Long 43° 25' West

18 Thursday July 10

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather squared the yards S E the match employed in various jobs 2 sails insight Middle part calm Latter part the same the match employed in various jobs So ends Lat 36° 45' N Long 43° 01' West

19 Friday July 11

These 24 hours commenced with calm weather course E S E the match employed in various jobs one sail insight Middle part pleasant Latter part the same saw some Blackfish lowered and struck and got 3 Larboard Boat 2 and 3 Starboard Boat one So ends these 24 hours

Latitude 36° 51' N Longitude 42° 27'

20 Saturday July 12

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather course E by S employed in stowing the Blackfish one sail insight Middle part pleasant Latter part pleasant with a strong breeze saw some Blackfish But did not lower So ends these 24 hours

Latitude 37° 11' North Long 39° 42' West

21 Sunday July 13th

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather and a strong wind steering E by S Middle the same course steering E S E Latter part the same 4 sails insight Course East So ends these 24 hours

Latitude 37° 38' North Long 36° 25' West

22 Monday July 14

These 24 hours commenced with pleasant weather course steering E 4 sails insight at 5 PM had a squall of rain hauled down the jib a 1/2 jib Middle part a west Latter part the same employed in various jobs So ends

Latitude 37° 31' North Long 33° 55' West
