

Bark Catalpa on a Whaling voyage sailed June 20th 1854
At sea.

23 Tuesday July 15

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather steering by the wind heading S & the watch employed in various jobs one sail insight Middle part pleasant course steering S by N latter part the same so ends these 24 hours

Latitude 38°44' N Long 83°06' West

24 Wednesday July 16

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather steering S by N the watch employed in setting up the head Rigging Middle part pleasant course steering S by N at daylight made the island of Flores and Harco latter part pleasant steering in for the land lying off and on at Flores so ends

25 Thursday July 17

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather lying off and on at Flores the mast boat went on shore at 6 P.M. came off shipped three men tacke trucked off shore at 4 hauled up the coarce and took in the fore top gallant sail and gaff topsail Middle part pleasant latter part the same 3 sails insight course steering N & the watch employed in breaking out the fore hole for Boards so ends these 24 hours

26 Friday July 18

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather course N & the watch employed in breaking out the fore hole for water Boards 3 sails insight at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark Thomas pope of New Bedford Middle part steering Bruge took in the fore and main top gallant sails and fly Jib at 10 the captain came on board latter part the same the watch employed in breaking out for water so ends these 24 hours

27 Saturday July 19

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather steering by the wind heading S & employed in storing off the main hatchway Middle part the same tacke to the S W latter part the same at 6 tacke to the S & the watch employed in various jobs so ends these 24 hours

28 Sunday July 20

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather steering by the wind heading S & 3 islands insight the western islands the watch employed in ships duty Middle part pleasant tacke to the E at 3 tacke heading N & W 3 islands insight latter part the same one sail insight off the weather quarter so ends these 24 hours

Latitude 39°23' N Long 27°50' W

29 Monday July 21

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather steering by the wind heading S & the land still insight at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark active of N Bedford captain maul Middle part pleasant struck a porpoise and saved him latter part the same the watch employed in ships duty so ends these 24 hours

30 Tuesday July 22

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather steering by the wind 3 sails insight at 3 P.M. spoke the active and the Bark Martin of New Bedford captain Deblid Middle part pleasant lying with the main yard aback at daylight kept off E by S 2 sails insight latter part the same employed in ships duty so ends these 24 hours
