Saturday August 2

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather turned the reefs out of the fore topsail and set the jib and fly jib at sundown Reaped the fore and main topsail and took in the fly jib and jib Middle part pleasant latter part the same Employed in setting up the main topmast Back stays & ends

Sunday August 3

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather By the wind of the Bark Belle of marren the captain went on board of her Middle part pleasant latter part the same standing in for the Land & ends these 24 hours

Monday August 4

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather the boat went on shore at places Middle part Pleasant latter part the same Employed in breaking up masted at 9 AM and the island of Fayall at 4 PM the captain went on shore & ends these 24 hours

44

Tuesday August 5

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather Employed in lying off and on at Fayall Middle part pleasant latter part the same Employed in lying off and on at Fayall & ends

Wednesday August 6

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather Employed in lying off and on at 1 PM the captain came on board and made sail Middle part at sundown took in sail and hauled aback the main yard latter part the same & ends these 24 hours

Thursday August 7

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather and the island of Terceira Middle part pleasant top in the topgallant sails were hauled up the fore sail and hauled aback the main yard & more ship and stood to the N.W. at daylight tacked to latter part the same made all sail 4 sails insight & ends these 24 hours

Friday August 8

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather Employed in lying off and on at Terceira at 1 PM the captain came on shore at sundown the captain came on board and Reaped the topsails and tacked off shore Middle part strong wind furled the jib and sparker and mainsail latter part the same took in the fore topsail & ends

48

Saturday August 9

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather 3 sails insight Middle part squally latter part pleasant at daylight Made all sail 3 sails insight the mate Employed in ships duty took in the main top gallant sail & ends these 24 hours

49

Sunday August 10

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather tacked ship 3 sails insight and the Land at sundown Double Reaped the topsails and tacked ship Middle part squally Middle part squally latter part the same & ends these 24 hours

Monday August 11

These 24 hours commences with pleasant weather turned the reefs out of the main topsail and set the jib and mainsail Middle part pleasant made all sail at daylight tacked ship latter part the same & ends these 24 hours
