in ships duty So ends these 24 hours

63 Sunday August 24
Commences with squally weather Course steering
S by S Middle part pleasant Latter part the same
23 sails insight So ends these 24 hours
Latitude 38° 34' Longitude 23° 16' W

64 Monday August 25
Commences with pleasant weather Course steering
at 11 P.M. spoke a portage Boat Middle part the
same steering set the main Royal Latter part
the same the match Employed in Breaking out
for water So ends these 24 hours

65 Tuesday August 26

at 11 P.M. at 8 P.M. saw the western Islands

and stood out to sea Middle part pleasant
Latter part the same So ends

68 Friday August 29
Commences with pleasant weather Course
S W Employed in ships duty at 4 P.M. lowered
for Black fish struck and saved one & sails
insight Middle part pleasant Latter part
pleasant Employed in setting up the
Main topmast Rigging So ends

69 Saturday August 30
Commences with pleasant weather steering
by the wind the Land still insight at 5 P.M.
shook the mizzen and G. L. of N Bedford
Middle part squally Course steering W S W at
Daylight made all sail and kept off S S W Latter
part squally So ends these 24 hours

70 Sunday August 31
Commences with squally weather Course S S E
Middle part strong Breeze took in the fly fore
fore top gallant sail aft topsail at daylight saw 2 sails
set the fore top gallant sail and fly fore hauled up the spanker
Course S by E So ends
