Part the same the watch employed in setting up
the fly Gib Martingale and some humpbacks
So ends Lat 37.5 S South Long 47.00

Thursday November 13

Commences with pleasant weather Course S W by S
Middle part a gale of wind Double Reefed the
Topsails and furled the Gib and mainsail
Latter part strong Breeze and Calm, steering
by the wind heading S E So ends

Lat 39.30 S Long 48.22 West

Friday November 14

Commences with with a strong Breeze tacked
Ship heading W by S Middle part pleasant weath
Made sail Latter part the same same some
finbacks employed in setting up the fly
Gib martingale So ends these 24 hours

Lat 39.40 South Long 48.58 West

Saturday November 15

Commences with pleasant weather Course steering
S W by S at sundown took in the Waist Boat
Middle part a gale of wind Latter part the
same So ends these 24 hours

Lat 41.04 S Long 49.34 West

Sunday November 16

Commences with a gale of wind at 1 more ship
heading S W by W wind S W lying two under a
double Reefed maintopsail and foresail Middle
part strong Breeze Latter part the pleasant and
a night whale lowered for skin but did not strike
So ends Lat 41.04 South Long 49.34 West

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Monday November 17

Commences with pleasant weather Course
S W by S and some finbacks Middle part
strong Breeze took in the Main top gallant
sail and fly Gib and double Reefed the
Topsails Latter part the same So ends

Tuesday November 18

Commences with pleasant weather steering by
the wind heading S lowered for humpbacks
but did not strike Middle pleasant Latter
part the same So ends these 24 hours

Lat 42.00 S Long by chronometer 51.33 W
Long by sun 51.33 W

Wednesday November 19

Commences with a strong Breeze steering
by the wind heading S W by S Middle part
Calm Latter part Breeze took in the top
gallant sails and fly Gib so ends

Thursday November 20

Commences with pleasant weather and Calm
Course S W by S Middle part pleasant Latter
part the same employed in ships duty
So ends these 24 hours

Middle part calm Latter part Breeze and
Calm So ends No observation to day
