Bark Catalpa on her passage to Cape Horn Oct 26

Saturday November 22

Commences with Rainy weather and a calm took in the top gallant sails jib and fly jib at 4 P.M. wore ship by the wind heading W S W Middle part a gale of wind Larre down to close Reefed Middle Main topsail and a foresail So ends these 24 hours

Lat 43° 38' South Long 53° 36' West

Sunday November 23

Commences with a gale of wind lying too with under a close Reefed Middle Main topsail and a Reefed foresail at 5 P.M. Wore ship heading S S W Middle part Middle part strong Breeze furled the jib and Mainsail spanker Latter part a gale of wind So ends these 24 hours

Lat 43° 13' S Long 53° 57' West

Monday Novem 24

Commences with a strong Breeze steering by the wind heading S S W at 2 P.M. set the mainsail and jib at sundown turned the Reefs out of the Main topsail Middle part pleasant Latter part the same spoke a schooner Bound to Montevideo she belonged to Falkland Islands so end

Commences with Pleasant weather steering by the wind heading S W by W Middle part pleasant steering by the wind heading S W by S Latter part the same Employed in ships duty steering by the wind heading W S W So ends

Wednesday November 26

Commences with squally weather steering by the wind heading S by E at 6 P.M. tacked ship heading W by N Double Reefed the Topsails wind S W Middle part pleasant Latter part the same at daylight Made all sail So ends these 24 hours

Thursday Novem 27

Commences with pleasant weather Course steering by W S W Middle part a gale of wind double Reefed topsails and furled the jib and Mainsail Latter part, Much the same Made sail So ends Course W S W

Friday Novem 28

Commences with a gale of wind Double Reefed the topsails at sundown Moderated Middle part a gale of wind Latter part the same lying to under a close Reef main topsail and foresail So ends

Commences with a gale of wind lying to under a close Reef Main topsail and a Reef foresail Middle part the same Latter part moderated turned a Reef out of the Main topsail and foresail So ends

Commences with pleasant weather Course steering South Middle part pleasant Latter part the same So ends
