Commences with pleasant weather and a strong wind Course S at 6 P.M. Double Reefed the fore topsail Middle part pleasant steering by the wind heading S E latter part the same So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday December 2

Commences with pleasant wind tacked ship heading W S W Middle part pleasant tacked ship Course steering S by W latter part the same Employed in Breking out for water Bread So ends
Latitude 49.59 S Long 63.24 West

Wednesday Decem 3

Commences with pleasant weather Course steering S by W Middle part squally Double Reefed the topsails latter part the same So ends
Latter 52.08 S Long 63.21 West

Thursday December 4

Commences with pleasant weather Course S E at sundown luffed up S Middle part Pleasant latter part squally Double Reefed the topsails So ends these 24 hours
Latitude 53.50 S Long 63.38 West

Friday December 5

Commences with a gale of wind furled the mainsail and Reefed the foresail Middle part the same latter part squally Employed in ships duty So ends
Latitude 53.47 S Long 63.47 West

Saturday December 6

Commences with pleasant weather Made still sail at 4 P.M. more ship Middle part Rainy Course steering S latter part thick & cloudy weather at 7 A.M. Made Staten Land
Lat 54.36 S Long 63.06 West Staten Land

Sunday Decem 7

Commences with pleasant weather the weather the Land still in sight Middle part Pleasant Course steering S S W latter part thick Rainy Course steering S S W So ends
Latitude 58.08 S Long 65.58 West

Monday Decem 8

Commences with thick Rainy weather Course S by W Middle part thick Rainy weather Course S by S latter part the same Wind kept off W S W So ends
Lat 57.01 South Long 69.10 West

Tuesday Decem 9

Commences with thick weather C W S W Middle part squally latter part much the same & Employed in ships duty So ends these 24 hours
Lat 57.10 South Long 69.57 West

Wednesday Decem 10

Commences with squally weather steering by the wind heading S S E Middle part much the same latter part Rainy steering by the heading W S W Broke out for water So ends
Saw a spanish Bark
