Monday Decem 29

Commences with pleasant weather course steering
N by E and a ship Bound to the southward
With her fore and main top gallant mast
over the side Middle part squally Latter part
Pleasant course N by E so ends

Commences with pleasant weather course
N by E Middle part Rainy Lying to under
a close Reefed Main topsail and a close
Reefed foresail Latter part the same so ends

Commences with thick weather tacked
ship heading N by E Middle part thick
Weather but calm Latter part Moderated
Breeze so ends these 24 hours

Commences with pleasant weather course
steering N by E Middle part Rainy Lying to
under a close Reef Main topsail and a Reef foresail
Latter part foggy steering by wind heading N
so ends

Friday January 2

Commences with Rainy weather steering N by E
Middle part much the same Latter foggy steering
by the wind heading from N by E to N by E
Employed in Running sinkers so ends

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Saturday Dec 31 January 3

Commences with thick foggy weather steering
by the wind heading N by E Middle part
Rainy at daylight tacked ship heading
N Latter part foggy Employed in
Washing ship so ends
No observations

Sunday January 4

Commences with foggy weather steering
by the wind heading N Employed in
Washing ship Middle part foggy weather
tacked ship heading N Double Reefed the
fore and main topsail Latter part
a gale of wind Lying to under a
Close Reef Main topsail and a
Reefed foresail so ends

Lat 40° 40' S Long 79

Monday Jan 5

Commences with Rainy weather Lying
to under a close Reef Main topsail and
a Reefed foresail more ship heading N by E
set the fore topsail and turned one Reef
out of the main ship off N by E Middle part
pleasant Latter part the same Employed in Breaking
out the apert hole so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday January 6

Commences with pleasant weather Employed in
Painting the Weather Vails and starboard Boat Middle
Part pleasant Latter part the same Employed in
flecting the Boats and other small jobs so ends
