Whales gone to windward so ends this day

Thursday July the 1st  
This day commences with fine weather gentle  
Breeze from the S ship steering S by E empty  
shending sail at half past 8th raised with  
Water of log low several furla ok borest by  
Sail took in again middle part fine latter part  
Unit water swept off shortened sail were ship so ends

Friday July the 2nd  
This day commences with fine weather gentle  
Breeze from the S ship heading S by E made sail  
In windward to work on sail latter part fine shortened  
Sail to ends this day of grace got supper before gun

Saturday July the 3rd  
This day commences with fine weather gentle  
Breeze from the S ship steering on the wind sent in gill for  
shending last another 4 sails to windward employed  
Signature sail slashed masts middle part fine last  
Latter broke out beef pork shortened sail were ship

Sunday July the 4th  
This day commences with squally weather got breakfast  
Double reefed topsail raised white water was ship  
Middle part same latter part two sails were ship  
Blowing a clear gale short reefed fore mizen  
Set watch at 10th this day of grace ends

Monday July the 4th  
This day commences with squally weather from the  
S ship steering on the wind brook out reefs sent  
Down fore topsail bound gill mainsail fixed foremast  
Sent up another topsail middle part strong breeze  
Latter part short reefed fore mizen furlled gill were

Tuesday July the 5th  
This day commences with squally weather from the S  
Ship on the wind heading S by E two sails to windward  
Middle part squally latter part same were ship ends

Wednesday July the 6th  
This day commences with squally weather from the S  
On the wind heading S by E two sails to windward  
Part new strap on topsail making black cloth reefed  
fore and mizen foresail sail to lower middle part  
Same latter part were ship heading S by E ends

Thursday July the 7th  
This day commences with moderate weather from the S  
Ship on the wind were ship employed breaking out  
Water middle part same latter had a row with  
One foremast hand about stopping with below  
furlled mainsail were ship ends this day of grace

Friday July the 8th  
This day commences with squally weather from the S  
Ship on the wind bound mainsail bound went aft for  
Sugar sail to windward middle part same were  
Latter part furlled mainsail and gill were ship

Saturday July the 10  
This day commences with strong breeze from the S  
On the wind bound gill washed off sail to windward  
Middle part same latter part shortened sail 5 sails insight

Sunday July the 11th  
This day commences with squally weather from Eastered  
Ship on the wind heading S by E bound mainsail applied  
Rainbrace middle part spoke bark amoude ship's mast  
Repairing off for her squally captain went aboard galled  
2nd sperm seen whales scarce now growing modest  
Now look for butter and potatoes for supper
