This day commences with fine weather from ESE

Saw pinback middle part fine latter part wore ship
Caught fish all sail out to night so ends this

Wednesday July the 14th
This day commences with fine weather calm water
Off wore ship heading S got up maintop then S
Middle part fine latter sent down maintop then
Put up old one pumped ship so ends this day now

Thursday July the 15th
This day commences with fine weather from East
Wore ship broke out water 5 sails in sight middle
Wore ship light sail in latter part double reefed for
And maintopsails single men pulled courses so ends

Friday July the 16th
This day commences with fine weather from East
Wore ship 9 mainsails wore ship shook out reefs sent down
Foresail saw pinback middle part fine latter gained
With constation shortened sail so ends plenty of sails

Saturday July the 17th
This day commences with squally weather from East
Ship on the wind 4 sails in sight double reefed foresail
Shook out reefs single men pulled mainsail wore ship heading
S middle fine pumped ship set new main top sail latter part
Furled mainsail wore ship heading S so ends this

Sunday July the 18th
This day commences with squally weather from E ship
Heading S by E foresail mainsail shook reef out main top
5 sails in sight middle part fine latter shortened sail
Pumped ship so ends this day of grace now you look
looking for whales so ends this day of grace now

Monday July the 19th arch ground
This day commences with strong squalls from East
Unluffed fore gill two sails in sight middle part
Furled gill latter part kept off NW lost reefed
Fore main worn topsails luffed to the wind pump

Tuesday July the 20th
This day commences with squally weather from East
Shook out reef of the main top sail wore ship kept NW
Sent in gill for mending middle part squally latter part
Shook out reef fore top sail 5 sails in sight shortened
Sail took in gill foresail shanked wore ship moderate
Made sail again middle part took in gill so ends

Wednesday July the 21st
This day commences with squally weather from East
3 sails in sight loose mainsail freed gill gasket and
Middle part more moderate latter part furled main
Wore ship heading SSE pumped ship so ends this

Thursday July the 22nd
This day commences with moderate weather from East
Pumped ship wore ship heading SSE fine so it is so
Middle part fine latter part sent new main top sail
Furled mainsail so ends this day of grace citizening

Friday July the 23rd
This day commences with fine weather gentle breeze
From E ship steering 3 different courses 8 sails in sight
Tack ship at noon heading S fixing shives middle part fine
Latter part gammed Constitution wore ship shortened

Saturday July the 24th
This day commences with fine weather from ESE
Wore ship at 4 AM made sail 8 sails in sight so till
Latter part shortened sail so ends this day of grace

Sunday July the 25th
This day commences with fine weather from SSE
Ship steering SSW luffed on the wind middle part
Kept SSW fine sail in sight latter part fine luffed
Ship so ends this day of grace now look sharp

Monday July the 26th
This day commences with strong breeze from E ship
On the wind took in light sail broke out water
