Tuesday August the 24th
This day commences with squally weather from S
Raised spout of weather beam wore ship furled mainsail
Kept off NW till 10 AM braced up on starboard tack middle
part same latter part saw a ship to leeward take
A whale got main top sail took it in again furled
Mainsail pumped ship so ends this day

Wednesday August the 25th
This day commences with fine weather from SE
3 sails in sight broke out bread middle part fine
Saw boats toward for whales made all sail to
Ship at 4 PM saw a lone whale running toward
toward 3 boats at sundown but did not see him
Shortened sail set watch so ends this day

Thursday August the 26th
This day commences with fine weather 4 sails in sight
One boiling sent in gill for mending sent down
For top sail for mending middle part fine wore
Latter part lowered main top sail swept off rain got sup
Shortened sail rain heavy squalls of it now log

Friday August the 27th
This day commences with fine weather from NE sails
Saw fin back ship on the wind SE & middle part
Fine latter part raining calm some breeze kept NW
Shortened sail braced up on starboard tack pumped

Saturday August the 28th
This day commences with fine weather from SE
8 sails in sight squared yards steering NW making
Seasing stuff man got over board on 27 middle part fine
Latter part fine shortened sail so ends this day of grace

Sunday August the 29th
This day commences with fine weather from SE ship
Macle sail 3 sails in sight wore ship heading SE & now
Middle part fine latter part saw a ship

Monday August the 30th at sea
This day commences with strong wind double reefed to heads
Macle gill shanked kept off NW while set up to sail out clouds
Saw a white water bent for sail over middle part 2 sails in
Latter part swept off got supper wore ship heading S so ends this

Tuesday August the 31st
This day commences with squally weather double reefed fore mizen
Layed gill wore ship heading NW by N lowered mainsail middle
Latter saw water spout pumped ship wore round on the larboard tack
heading S so ends this day sail in sight so ends this day

Wednesday September the 1st
This day commences with squally weather from SE & give double
Wore ship heading NW by N mate knotting shungaru rain
Middle part same wore ship steering SE sail in sight latter
Part shook out reefs making shungaru set main and mizen

Thursday Sept the 2nd
This day commences with fine weather from SE wore ship
Hove fore & sail buntlines got breakfast sent down fore sail
4 sails in sight middle part fine latter part sent up to haul
Broke out beef back or spae hauled up mainsail we tacked ship
To get away from her pumped ship took in fly gill so ends

Friday Sept the 3rd
This day commences with fine weather from SE ship on the
Sent down mainsail for mending 3 sails in sight fin back
Middle part fine latter part bent mainsail sent down
Main top sail put up another broke out flour took in light sail
At 11 at night a large ship came very near taking our fly gill

Saturday Sept the 4th
This day commences with fine weather from SE ship on
The wind wore ship broke out water one sail in sight middle
Part fine latter part seagings on foremast rat things wore ship
Pumped ship so ends this day of grace now boys will you now

Sunday Sept the 5th
This day commences with fine weather from SE give her legs
Squared yards steering NW NW sail to windward middle part
fine braced yards a little fly fish come in on back latter part
Braced up on starboard tack shortened sail pumped ship
so ends this day of grace now boys will you now
