Sail pumped ship so ends this day Two sails in sight to

Thursday Oct the 14th
This day commences with fine weather two sails in sight to
Broke out water raised low whale lowered bow boat
Lowered about 8 AM whale started to windward after
giving chances to kill him schooner E. A. Lewis in sight
Run out of sight of the ship cut got aboard at sundown gannets

Friday Oct the 15th
This day commences with fine made sail schooner ahead
Middle part fine broke out beef tacked ship got lost
Off the house put on boy cranes latter shot and sail
Pumped ship so ends this day of grace blowing strong

Saturday Oct the 16th
This day commences with strong breeze under double reef
Topsails were ship heading steering N.W. windward boat
Middle same latter at 3 PM braced up on starboard tack
Put boat on the house set staysail lat 14-08 long 78-56

Sunday Oct the 17th
This day commences with fine weather shoot out reef saw
Humpbacks middle fine set main top fly gib latter shot
Sail tacked ship lat 14-08 long 78-44 so ends this day

Monday Oct the 18th
This day commences with fine weather from ESE
Raised killers thought they was whales hauled up gannets
Till captain went aloft and pronounced them down looks and

Balaoe Lat 14-16 long 78-31
Broke out water so ends this day of grace now boys

Tuesday Oct the 19th
This day commences with fine weather employed paint
Boats now boys for whals middle part fine latter shot and
Sail so ends Lat 14-22 long 78-34 West

Wednesday Oct the 20th
This day commences with squally weather from ESE
Boats aboard double reefed fore mizen middle part fine
latter broke out beef pork took in sail lat 14-10 long 78-49

Thursday Oct the 21st
This day commences with fine weather gentle breeze from
Steering N.E. saw sunfish pinback squid middle fine
latter kept N.W. put bow boat on the rains took in sail
lat 14-25 long 78-11 so ends this day now boys

Friday Oct the 22nd
This day commences with fine weather steering S.W. made
Made sail middle fine latter were ship so ends this
lat 14-20 long 78-55 Saturday Oct the 23rd

This day commences with fine weather made sail broke
Out water middle part fine latter were ship shot and sail
long 78-55 lat 14-20 Sunday Oct the 24th

This day commences with strong breeze from ESE so raised
Boat whaler lowered inshore chased all day took in light
Sail latter tacked ship double reefed fore mizen topsails
lat 14-22 long 78-23 Monday Oct the 25th

This day commences with fine weather whole topsails now
To work at ships duty middle part same latter reefed tops
Tacked ship lat 14-29 long 78-17 so ends this day now

Tuesday Oct the 26th
This day commences with fine weather squared yards steered
Took in mainsail so ends this day lat 14-34 long 78-12

Wednesday Oct the 27th
This day commences with fine weather took in fly gib
Run down head sails middle fine steering N.W. sent gib
latter raised whales after running them under the bow

Called them starting to windward boat up for them but
to go lat 14-35 long 78-24 Scott whaler
