

Thursday Nov the 18th 1858

This day commences with fine weather ship heading S by W Tacked middle water employed ship's duty latter same so ends this day of grace now logs

Friday Nov the 19th

This day commences with fine weather employed at fixing left brace blocks & tacked ship middle fine latter tacked ship saw white water set mizzen sail

Saturday Nov the 20th

This day commences with fine weather ship heading S by W wet hole pumped ship set the roosters to fighting Raised white water wore ship is painted white streak

Sunday Nov the 21st

This day commences with strong breeze took in fore & main Raised white water wore ship middle same latter took in Tegalantails fly gib tacked ship latter same pumped ship

Monday Nov the 22nd

This day commences with equally weather wore ship pump Sent in gibb sent it out again middle fine latter to Took in fly gib Tegalantails pumped ship so ends

Tuesday Nov the 23rd

This day commences with fine weather from S by E Employed knotting yards fixing cask middle fine latter making spinnaker cleared down mizzen Tackled out earings swept off got supper had Mate had a row with fore mast hand so ends fine

Wednesday Nov the 24th

This day commences with fine weather from S by E ship heading S by W Tacked ship heading S by W loose mizzen fly gib making spinnaker middle part fine latter shended mizzen sail bent another maintop sail unrove maintop sail sheets wore ship so ends fine last

Thursday Nov the 25th

This day commences with fine weather ship on the wind Employed making up spinnaker set up fly gib guies Saw cow fish middle part fine latter broke out water Tacked ship land in sight saw finbacks fly gib proposed so ends this day of grace now logs Every one before have a white downy

This Nov the 26th 1858 Calao

This day commences with fine weather ship S by S sent Put up big tackle over fore hatch run ship into a large school of sperm whales took them for blackfish owing to having No glass to mast head wore ship wheels started to windard Middle fine later took chase with boats but no one came aboard Boat run down wore ship got supper took in fly gib mizzen Hauled up mainsail so ends this day of grace now logs

Saturday Nov the 27th

This day commences with fine weather made sail wet hole Bled out oil slushed masts put on roasting on four rig saw Black fish proposed middle part fine latter saw bark & in back so ends this day of grace now logs will you

Sunday Nov the 28th

This day commences with fine weather two sails in sight Tacked ship heading S by W middle latter same took in light sail

Monday Nov the 29th

This day commences with fine weather ship on the wind Tacked in moving with two wind S by E middle fine Unrove top sail sheets saw finbacks white water proposed in sight latter bent fore & main shotened

Tuesday Nov the 30th

This day commences with strong wind hauled down Course set main & fore & saw hump back rollers Middle fine latter squared yards storing S by W saw sail Pumped ship took in sail luffed to on board tack

Wednesday December 1st

This day commences with fine weather from S by E ship Tackled broke out sails water raised whales going to him Made all sail luffed to the wind kept off again middle fine latter lowered all three boats struck waste boat lost line Bow leeward killed got away after dark shotened sail

Thursday December the 2nd

This day commences with fine weather employed at cutting in middle latter same commenced boiling sharkout Reef mizzen top sail comes hard half watches a day

Friday December the 3rd

This day commences with fine weather boiling saw grain latter made sail took in again so ends this day
