

Calace 1858 Saturday Dec the 4th

This day commences with fine weather from 8 o'clock
Ship reaching 8 o'clock employed boiling saw grasses
middle part fine latter broke out water deep water
Cil 35 put on lines so ends this day now logs both

Sunday Dec the 5th

This day commences with fine weather wet hole saw
Carried forward dead whale got him alongside cut him in
What we shot the first day with lumber once latter
Commenced boiling barley wore ship so ends this day

Monday Dec the 6th

This day commences with fine weather get through boiling
Set small washed off made sail pumped ship raised
White water four points on the bow took off proved
Nothing middle fine latter same so ends this day

Tuesday Dec the 7th

This day commences with fine weather broke out water
Sails kept ports fixed arch door middle latter
Inshore latter sent down main royal set mizzen royal
Saw blackfish so ends this day of grace now logs

Wednesday Dec the 8th

This day commences with fine weather middle fine latter
Broke out flour so ends this day of grace now logs

Thursday Dec the 9th

This day commences with fine weather raised whale
At daylight going to tow a small sail got through
Then lowered bow boat struck killed plenty of them
Took him along side whale to windward cut him in
Shortened sail employed cutting blubber so ends this

Friday Dec the 10th

This day commences with fine weather raised whale
At daylight to windward did not get a chance beat to
induced middle fine latter took in light sail started

Saturday Dec the 11th

This day commences with fine weather employed
Boiling made sail middle fine broke out cask latter

Sunday Dec the 12th

This day employed boiling broke out water cut
What we shot the first day with lumber once latter

Calace Monday Dec the 13th 1858

This day commences with fine weather took off pots
Put on lines saw blackfish popoia middle fine latter
Took off pots swept off took in light sail so ends this

Tuesday Dec the 14th

This day commences with fine weather broke out water
Kept fixing round middle fine latter tacked ship
In sight swept off got supper finished ship so

Wednesday Dec the 15th

This day commences with strong wind took in main
And cross jack employed coopers oil wore ship
Middle latter same put up tackles for ship

Thursday Dec the 16th

This day commences with strong breeze under double
Kept fore and six sails employed stowing
Down oil to work at all 3 hatches latter wore ship

Friday Dec the 17th

This day commences with fine weather called all
Hands at daylight made sail washed off employed
Breaking out between decks and washing ship inside
Scrubbed ship deck with the shortened sail so ends this

Saturday Dec the 18th

This day commences with fine weather gentle breeze
Made sail wet hole scraped and shined masts middle
Fine latter broke out flour so shortened sail wore ship so

Sunday Dec the 19th

This day commences with fine weather gentle breeze
Made sail caught dauphin middle latter fine caught
Took in sail wore ship so ends this day of grace now

Monday Dec the 20th

This day commences with fine weather made sail got
The fore beards for potato pen middle washed
Ship outside latter took in gib quies put fore below
Swept off took in sail wore ship so ends this

Tuesday Dec the 21st

This day commences with fine weather employed
Painting ship middle latter same took in sail so ends
Boiling potato pen so ends this day of grace
Nothing more to be seen now logs
