Tuesday April the 12th
This day commences with squally weather
Fixed binnacle light iron poles broke down
Middle squally latter took in fly gib light
Sail pumped ship reefed topsails so ends

Wednesday April the 13th
This day commences with fine weather
Gentle breeze 1 give topsails broke out water
Reefed topsails pumped ship middle same
Latter pumped ship latter lat 25 52 so ends

Thursday April the 14th
This day commences with squally weather
Shook out reefs out main mizzen topsails
Reefed again pumping ship every 2 hours back end
Making scrubboons middle squally latter full
Mainsail first watch gib close reefed fore topsails
Middle watch spanker so ends this day
27-31 by 110

Friday April the 15th
This day commences with squally weather ship
On the wind heading by 8 double reef for mizzen
Close reef fore gib spanker furled blowing a gale now
Shifted fore buntlines middle latter same close
Reefed topsails lat 28 30 so ends this day

Saturday April the 16th
This day commences with fine weather ship
Steering by 8 loose royals set up bobetays row
Langard at up back stays middle fine latter
To work on rigging pumped ship so ends this

Sunday April the 17th
This day commences with fine weather gentle
Breeze steering by 8 middle fine took in top
Latter set legal ant sails so ends this day

Monday April the 18th lat 30 long 104
This day commences with fine weather set
Royals steering by 8 & rose top sail hoisted and
Got up tools put them in box middle fine
Latter hauled down ant tack pumped ship so ends

Tuesday April the 19th
This day commences with fine weather gentle
Breeze heavy swell steering by 8 Took in gib
Fore the wind latter more moderate loose gib
Shook out reefs so ends this day lat long 38

Wednesday April the 20th
This day commences with strong wind from North
Made all sail split fly gib took it in for mend
Splitting scrubbing teeth middle fine bent fly gib
Latter took in light sail set it again made gaskets
Pumped ship lat 32 1/2 long 99 1/2 West

Thursday April the 21st
This day commences with strong wind all sail
Middle fine broke out water latter took in top
Latter fixed pumped ship so ends this day
long 97-19

Friday April the 22nd
This day commences with strong wind ship
Steering by 8 pickled scrubboons teeth middle
Fine latter reefed topsails pumping ship every
long 99-37 lat 34-18

Saturday April the 23rd
This day commences with fine weather gentle
Breeze it tegals slushed masts by 8 middle
Fine latter took in light sail latter reefed
long 91 1/2

Sunday April the 24th
This day commences with strong wind
Shook out one reef out main topsail sent down
Tackle main top reefed top sail furled gib
Mainsail top pin latter loose gib mainsail
Took it in again first watch close reefed fore
long 89 1/2

Monday April the 25th
This day commences with lousy weather shook
Out reefs set mizzenals pumped ship middle
Put all sail out latter raised fore spanker
W. late lowered called boats aboard took in
